

GOLFDARTS

GOLFDARTS is a fun, competitive game mixing elements of both golf and traditional darts.

OBJECT

The object of GOLFDARTS is to play all nine holes and have the lowest score.

GAME PLAY

Up to 4 people can play GOLFDARTS at a time. Players stand 6' from the board when throwing. For each hole, the players must first hit 1 fairway and then 1 green. Each player has up to 6 throws to close out any given hole. At the end of a hole, the player marks the number of strokes it took to complete the hole on the scorecard or any piece of paper. At the end of the game, the scores from the 9 holes are totaled and the person with the lowest score wins. Any dart that is at least half-way on any of the elements in the game counts. For instance, if a dart is at least half-way on a green, then that person is given credit for landing on the green. See below for explanations of sand traps, water hazards, and Sweet Spots.

SAND TRAPS AND WATER HAZARDS

If a player lands on a water hazard or sand trap anywhere on the board, he is penalized an extra stroke. If a player lands on a Sand trap on a fairway, then the person does progress to the green, but with an added penalty stroke.

SWEET SPOTS

The red dots are Sweet Spots. If a player lands on a Sweet Spot, then that throw does not count as a stroke. A Sweet Spot exists on each fairway and each green. If a player lands on a Sweet Spot, then that stroke does not count, and the player closes out that fairway or green. If a player lands his first dart on a Sweet Spot on the intended fairway, then hits his second dart on the Sweet Spot of the corresponding green, then both strokes do not count and the player receives a zero (0) for that hole, which is the equivalent of a hole-in-one. If a player hits a Sweet Spot on a fairway on his last (6th) throw, then that player advances to the green with an extra dart. If he hits the Sweet Spot on the green with that dart, then his final score would be a five (5) for that hole.
